## Life of Christ

Pharoah, the king of Egypt, gave orders to slay the male Hebrew children around the time of Moses' birth (Ex.1)



Herod, the king of the Jews, gave orders to slay the male Hebrew children around the time of Jesus' birth (Mt.2:16-18)

Pharoah learned of a liberator of Israel arising so he ordered the slaughter (**Ex.1:15**)



Herod learned of a liberator of Israel arising so he ordered the slaughter (Mt.2:2-18)

Moses is forced to leave his homeland to seek safety from Pharaoh (Ex.2:15)



Jesus is forced to leave his homeland to seek safety from Herod (Mt.2:12-14)

After Pharaoh's death, God appears to Moses to tell him to return to Egypt (**Ex.4:19**)



After Herod's death, an angel appears to Joseph to tell him to return to Israel (Mt.2:19-20)

Moses, with his wife and children, return to Egypt (Ex.4:20)



Joseph, with his wife and child, return to Israel (Mt.2:21)
