ANDREW BRINGS PEOPLE TO JESUS

Andrew's name means "manly." In all three instances of Andrew in the Gospel of John we find him bringing people to Jesus. What a great example he is for us today. He was the first to proclaim Jesus as the Messiah.

- Andrew brought his brother Peter to Jesus (Jn.1:41-42)

 Peter was a leader and very influential in the early church.
- Andrew brought a little boy before Jesus (Jn.6:4-9)

 This boy's 5 barley loaves and two small fish end up feeding 5,000 people. What an influence on that boy.
- Andrew brought Some Greeks before Jesus (Jn.12:20-22)

 These Greeks (God-fearers) came to worship during the Feast of Passover and Unleavened Bread.
