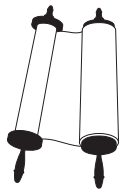


# JESUS KNEW WHAT WAS IN MAN

Several times in the Gospel of John, Jesus proves that He knew the heart of man. This knowledge helps man to understand that Jesus is the Son of God. The following is a list of examples where Jesus knew about them and what they were thinking.



<sup>23</sup>Now when he was in Jerusalem at the passover, in the feast day, many believed in his name, when they saw the miracles which he did. <sup>24</sup>But Jesus did not commit himself unto them, because he knew all men, <sup>25</sup>And needed not that any should testify of man: for he knew what was in man.” (Jn.2:23-25)



## The Character of Simon Peter (Jn.1:42)

He told Peter he was a stone.



## What Nathanael was like (Jn.1:46)

He knew Nathanael's character and what he was thinking (Jn.1:49-51).



## Samaritan Woman (Jn.4:29)

He told her “all things” she had done.



## Jewish Leaders (Jn.5:42)

He told the Jewish leaders they did not have love in their hearts.



## One Disciple Not a Believer (Jn.6:64)

He knew the heart of Judas.



## Adulteress Woman (Jn.8:10-11)

He knew the Scribes and Pharisees' heart (Jn.8:1-11).



## Enemies' Hearts (Jn.8:40)

He knew there was murder in the Pharisees' heart.
