## GOSPEL OF JOHN — "I AM" STATEMENTS WITH METAPHOR

These 7 signs demonstrate the deity of Jesus Christ. None of these are found in the Synoptic Gospels. The Gospel of John has 92% unique material not found in the Synoptic Gospels! Along with the phrase "I AM" Jesus uses metaphors to convey truths (bread, light, door, shepherd, resurrection (way, truth, life) and vine. There are other uses of the phrase, "I Am" employed in John's Gospel that are powerful statements concerning the Person of Christ's deity (Jn.8:58; 9:5; 10:36; 13:13, 9; 14:11, 20). The ones below in the chart are the passages that use the simple metaphors associated with the phrase, "I Am".

(Jn.14:6-7)	The Son alone can bring us into the presence of His Father, can counter the lies of Satan with truth, and can give us eternal life.  [He guides us through life's difficult ways]	LEADER
