

JOHN: JESUS PICTURES HIS DEATH

Several times in the Gospel of John, using multiple pictures, Jesus taught that He must die. His death and burial would look like a failure, but in the end, God would bring victory through it.

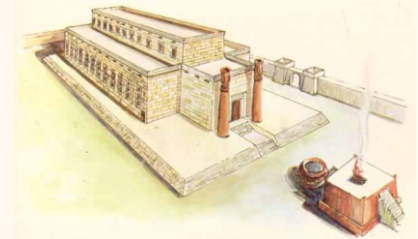
Lamb of God
(John 1:29,36)

Jesus' death would be that of a substitute for sinners.



The Temple
(John 2:14, 19-21)

Jesus' death would be a violent death, but would end in a victorious resurrection.



Serpent Lifted Up
(Nu.21:5-9; John 3:14)

Jesus would be made sin for us (1Pe.2:24). The Son of Man will be lifted up for all to see.



Good Shepherd
(John 10:11-18)

Jesus' death would be voluntary (Jn.10:11-18). He will lay down His life for the sheep.



The Seed
(John 12:20-25)

Jesus' death would produce fruit to the glory of God. The seed must first die.
