BURNT OFFERING



(1) It had to be a male without blemish (v.3)

- The offender is guilty, but the animal is not
- "But with the precious blood of Christ, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot (1Pe.1:19). Christ lived a perfect life.

(2) Offerer laid his hands on the head of the animal (v.4)

- Symbol of transferring guilt to the animal.
- This is the nature of faith
 - Transferring guilt from offender to the animal
 - Transferring confidence from self to Christ

(3) The death was personalized (v.5)

- The offender had to actually kill the animal with his own hands
- Cannot offer it for someone else. It was personal.

(4) The penalty for sin was death (v.5)

• The priest sprinkled blood. Only death could satisfy God.

(5) The Priest burned the entire sacrifice (v.6, 9)

- The sacrifice symbolized the wrath of God being satisfied
- It is an everlasting righteousness
- "My righteousness will be forever" (Is.51:8)
- "Not with the blood of goats and calves, but with His own blood He entered the Most Holy Place once for all, having obtained eternal redemption." (**He.9:12**)
