CONVICTION OF OTHERS — RO.14:13-23

1. Christians Affect Each Other (Ro.14:13-15)

¹³Therefore let us not judge one another anymore, but rather resolve this, not to put a <u>stumbling block</u> or a cause to fall in our <u>brother's way</u>. ¹⁴I know and am convinced by the Lord Jesus that there is nothing unclean of itself; but to him who considers anything to be unclean, to him it is unclean. ¹⁵Yet if your brother is grieved because of your food, you are no longer <u>walking in love</u>. <u>Do not destroy</u> with your food the one for whom Christ died. (**Ro.14:13-15**)

2. Christians Must Have Priorities (Ro.14:16-18)

¹⁶Therefore do not let <u>your good be spoken of as evil</u>; ¹⁷for the <u>kingdom of God</u> is not eating and drinking, but <u>righteousness and peace and joy</u> in the Holy Spirit. ¹⁸For he who serves Christ in these things is <u>acceptable to God</u> and <u>approved by men</u>. (**Ro.14:16-18**)

3. Christians Must Help Each Other Grow (Ro.14:19-21)

¹⁹Therefore let us pursue the things which make for peace and the things by which one may <u>edify another</u>.
²⁰Do not <u>destroy the work</u> of God for the sake of food. All things indeed are pure, but it is evil for the man who <u>eats with offense</u>. ²¹It is good neither to eat meat nor drink wine nor do anything by which your brother <u>stumbles</u> or is <u>offended</u> or is <u>made weak</u>. (**Ro.14:19-21**)

4. Christians Must Not Force Their Opinions on Others (Ro.14:22-23)

²²Do you have faith? <u>Have it to yourself before God</u>. Happy is he who does <u>not condemn himself</u> in what he approves. ²³But he who doubts is condemned if he eats, because he does not eat from faith; for whatever is not from faith is sin. (**Ro.14:22-23**)
