ROMANS 3 GIVES THE THEOLOGICAL CASE FOR JUSTIFICATION BY FAITH

- 3:21-23, 27-28 — Justification is Apart from the Law (the law requires faith)
- 3:24-26 — God is Himself Just (Evidence: Son sent to the cross)
- 3:26 — God is the One that Justifies (Evidence: Son sent to the cross)
- 3:28-31 — There is Only One God (Evidence: Jew & Gentile no difference)
 - One plan of salvation for OT and NT

ROMANS 4 GIVES THE ILLUSTRATIVE CASE FOR JUSTIFICATION BY FAITH

- How was Abraham Made Righteous? (v.6-8, David)

	POSITIVE	NEGATIVE
4:1-8	— Abraham was Justified by Faith	not Works
4:9-17	— Abraham was Justified by Grace	not Law
	4:9-12 - Issue of Circumcision	
	4:13-17 - Issue of Law	
4:18-25	— Abraham was Justified by Divine Power	not Human Effort
