JEWISH OBJECTIONS

Romans 3:1-8

OBJECTION 1: The People (v.1) YOU have attacked God's people

- "Paul, You Are Attacking the Character of God"
- "Paul, You Are Denying God's Noble Purposes in Calling us"



OBJECTION 2: The Law (v.2-4) YOU have attacked God's promises

- "Though some do not believe, does that cancel God's promises"
- "What good is having the Scriptures if unbelief cancels it?"
- In the midst of the sinfulness of men and the unbelief of Israel, God will still be glorified

OBJECTION 3: The Holy Place (v.5-8) YOU have attacked God's purity

- If our black velvet unfaithfulness gives greater glory to God's faithfulness, then our sin gives God glory.
- If our unfaithfulness gives God glory, then Paul is speaking against God's purity.
- How can I be seen as a sinner when I'm just doing such a good thing for God?
