COMPONENTS OF THE RIGHTEOUSNESS OF GOD

- 1 It is Apart from Legalism (v.21, "apart from the law")
- 2 It is Based on Revelation (v.21, "being witnessed by the Law and the Prophets")
- It is Acquired by Faith (v.22, "even the righteousness of God, through faith in Jesus Christ")
- 4 It is Provided for All [who believe] (v.22, "to all and on all who believe. For there is no difference")
- 6 It is Given through Grace (v.24, "being justified freely by His grace")
- 6 It is Very Costly (v.24, "through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus")
