OUTLINE AND WALK THROUGH — RO.8:12-17

PERFECT LOGIC of Sovereign Grace (v.12-13)

- The unregenerate believes he is obligated to satisfy his own flesh.
- Our debt (obligation) is to the Spirit, not to the flesh. This exhortation is our responsibility.
- The domain of the flesh is our bodies (Ro.6:6,12; 7:5).
- The flesh generates its passions in us desiring to reign (Ro.6:12, "do not let sin reign in your mortal body").
- The second group are those who "live according to the flesh". These are in Adam, thus, unregenerate.

- If we live out the desires of the flesh we will reap the wages of sin, death.
 - We cannot "put to death" the flesh but "by the Spirit".
 - The Spirit provides the continual power to gradually kill sin. This process is never completed in this life.
 - If we put to death the suggestions of the flesh, we are paying our debt to the Spirit (**Ro.6:11**, "count yourself...").

• As we walk in the Spirit we are killing (denying) the flesh. The body is where the flesh expresses itself (**Ro.6:6, 13**).

PRECIOUS ADOPTION as Children of God (v.14-15)

- The Spirit objectively leads His children through: V.14
 - 1. ILLUMINATION Divine clarifying to make Scripture understandable (**Ep.1:17-19**)
 - 2. SANCTIFICATION Divine enabling to help us obey Scripture (Ga.5:16-17, 24)
- We yield to the Spirit, and He guides us through His Word.
- The Holy Spirit is the sign of adoption ("sons of God")

- "Fear" The unregenerate are slaves (in bondage) to:
 - 1. Fear of death (He.2:14-15)
 - 2. Fear of final punishment (1Jn.4:18)
- "Adoption" Means, "being placed as an adult son" at the moment or rebirth.
- This is a Spirit-produced awareness that we belong to God.
- "Abba" We come to God without fear or hesitation as our beloved Father.
- First the HS says "Abba, Father" to us (**Ga.4:6**), then we say it to God.

POWERFUL PRIVILEGE as Joint-Heirs with Christ (v.16-17)

- The HS confirms the validity of our adoption:
 - 1. By the fruit He provides (Ga.5:22-23)
 - 2. By the power He provides (Ac.1:8)
- The Holy Spirit gives evidence ("bears witness") that we are His, by the prompting, "Abba, Father".
- We are promised an inheritance (Ga.3:29; Ep.1:11; 1Pe.1:4, "heirs" or "inheritance").
 - 1. We will inherit eternal salvation (Ti.3:7)
 - 2. We will inherit God Himself (Lm.3:24; Ps.73:25; Re.21:3)
 - 3. We will receive glory (Ro.5:2)
- As co-heirs with Christ we share in His sufferings (Jn.15:18-19; 2Co.4:17; 2Tm.3:12).
