- Reason for Setting Aside Nation Israel— Salvation of the Gentiles (11:13-21)
- Restoration of Nation Israel— Greater Blessing (11:22-32)

B. Doxology of praise to God (11:33-36)

- Reason for Restoring Nation Israel— Wisdom of God (11:33-36)
