# THE RESURRECTION GOSPEL

#### 1 Corinthians 15:1-11

## **Testimony of the Truly Redeemed (v.1-2)**

<sup>1</sup>Moreover, brethren, I declare to you the gospel which I preached to you, <u>which also you received</u> and <u>in which you stand</u>, <sup>2</sup>by which also <u>you are saved</u>, if you hold fast that word which I preached to you—unless you believed in vain.



### **Testimony of the Scripture (v.3-4)**

<sup>3</sup>For I delivered to you first of all that which I also received: that Christ died for our sins <u>according to the Scriptures</u>, <sup>4</sup>and that He was buried, and that He rose again the third day <u>according to the Scriptures</u>,





## **Testimony of Eyewitnesses (v.5-7)**

<sup>5</sup>and that He was seen by <u>Cephas</u>, then by <u>the twelve</u>. <sup>6</sup>After that He was seen by over <u>five</u> <u>hundred brethren</u> at once, of whom the greater part remain to the present, but some have fallen asleep. <sup>7</sup>After that He was seen by <u>James</u>, then by <u>all the apostles</u>.



## **Testimony of a Special Witness (v.8-10)**

<sup>8</sup>Then last of all He was <u>seen by me</u> also, as by one born out of due time. <sup>9</sup>For I am the least of the apostles, who am not worthy to be called an apostle, because I persecuted the church of God. <sup>10</sup>But by the grace of God I am what I am, and His grace toward me was not in vain; but I labored more abundantly than they all, yet not I, but the grace of God which was with me.



## **Testimony of a Common Message (v.11)**

<sup>11</sup>Therefore, <u>whether it was I or they, so we preach</u> and so you believed.
