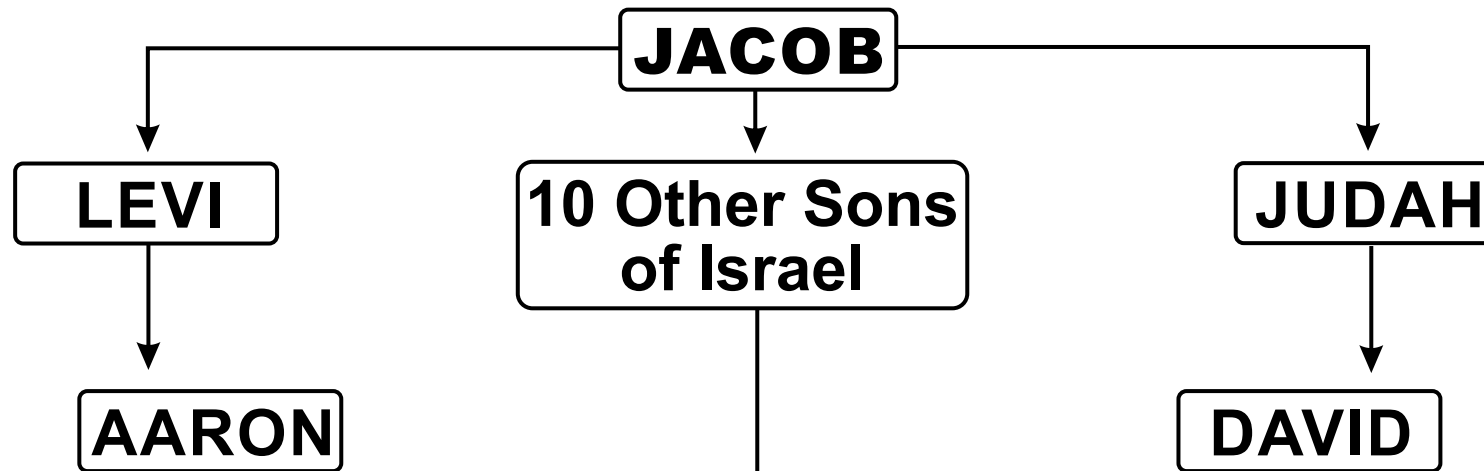


CHRIST AS PROPHET, PRIEST, AND KING – FUNCTION



Priest


- Leads with: Presence

- Concerned with: Plans
- Office: Rules

Priest "after the
order of Melchizedek"
(Hb.5:6,10; 6:20;
7:11; Ps.110:4)



PROPHET: A prophet of God is someone who reveals God and communicates truth to the people. Jesus came to reveal the Father (Mt.11:27).

PRIESTS: A priest offered sacrifices to God in order to cleanse the sin of the people. Jesus was the True Priest who offered Himself as the sacrifice (Ep.5:2; Hb.9:26-27; Ge.22:8).

KING: A king is someone who has authority to rule over a group of people. Jesus is the King Who will return to earth to rule during the Millennial Kingdom (Ps.95:3; Mt.27:11; Ph.2:10; Re.19:16).
