

7 PASSAGES — WORK OF CHRIST — HE.1:5-13

These 7 Old Testament quoted passages from Hebrews chapter one (Hb.1:5-13) impress upon the original readers the completeness of Christ's work. The Jewish readers considered the number 7 to convey the idea of the completed work of God. These texts demonstrate Jesus' rule in the coming Millennial Kingdom.
