## **MOSES: THE CHOICES OF FAITH (HE.11:23-29)**

## I. WHAT DOES TRUE FAITH REJECT (He.11:24-27)

- 1. He Rejected the World's PRESTIGE (v.24)
  - "By faith Moses, when he became of age, refused to be called the son of Pharaoh's daughter" (He.11:24)
- 2. He Rejected the World's PLEASURE (v.25)

"choosing rather to suffer affliction with the people of God than to enjoy the <u>passing pleasures of sin</u>" (*He.11:25*)

- 3. He Rejected the World's PLENTY (v.26)
  - "esteeming the reproach of Christ greater riches than the <u>treasures in Egypt</u>; for he looked to the reward" (*He.11:26*)
- 4. He Rejected the World's PRESSURE (v.27)

"By faith he forsook Egypt, not fearing the <u>wrath of the king</u>; for he endured as seeing Him who is invisible" (*He.11:27*)

## II. WHAT DOES TRUE FAITH ACCEPT (He.11:23,28-29)

- 1. True Faith Accepts the Lord's PLANS (v.23)
  - "By faith Moses, when he was born, was hidden three months by his parents, because they <u>saw he was a beautiful child</u>; and they were not afraid of the king's command" (*He.11:23*)
- 2. True Faith Accepts the Lord's PROVISION (v.28)

"By faith he <u>kept the Passover</u> and the <u>sprinkling of blood</u>, lest he who destroyed the firstborn should touch them." (*He.11:28*)

- 3. True Faith Accepts the Lord's PROMISE (v.29)
  - "By faith they passed through the Red Sea as by dry land, whereas the Egyptians, attempting to do so, were drowned." (*He.11:29*)
