CAPSTONES OF FAITH — HE.11:30-40

To Conquer in Struggle (v.30-34)

³⁰By faith the walls of Jericho fell down after they were encircled for seven days. ³¹By faith the harlot <u>Rahab</u> did not perish with those who did not believe, when she had received the spies with peace. ³²And what more shall I say? For the time would fail me to tell of <u>Gideon</u> and <u>Barak</u> and Samson and Jephthah, also of <u>David</u> and <u>Samuel</u> and the <u>prophets</u>: ³³who through faith <u>subdued kingdoms</u>, <u>worked righteousness</u>, <u>obtained promises</u>, stopped the mouths of lions, ³⁴quenched the violence of fire, escaped the edge of the sword, out of weakness were made strong, <u>became valiant in battle</u>, turned to flight the armies of the aliens. (**He.11:30-34**)

To Continue in Suffering (v.35-38)

Women received their dead raised to life again. Others were <u>tortured</u>, <u>not accepting deliverance</u>, that they might obtain a better resurrection. ³⁶Still others had trial of <u>mockings</u> and <u>scourgings</u>, yes, and of <u>chains and imprisonment</u>. ³⁷They were <u>stoned</u>, they were <u>sawn in two</u>, were <u>tempted</u>, were <u>slain with the sword</u>. They wandered about in sheepskins and goatskins, being <u>destitute</u>, <u>afflicted</u>, <u>tormented</u>— ³⁸of whom the world was not worthy. They <u>wandered</u> in <u>deserts</u> and mountains, in dens and caves of the earth. (**He.11:35-38**)

To Count on Salvation (v.39-40)

³⁹And all these, having obtained a good testimony through faith, did not receive the promise, ⁴⁰God having provided something better for us, that they should not be made perfect apart from us. (**He.11:39-40**)
