- 1. Two Perils in Discipline (He.12:5)
 - A. Despise God's Discipline (v.5, "do not despise") [Taking it lightly]
 - **1. By Callousness** (become hardened not soften heart)
 - **2. By Complaining** ("God, you have forsaken me")
 - **3. By Questioning** ("You could have told me some other way")
 - 4. By Carelessness (failure to change by not caring)
 - B. Despondent toward God's Discipline (v.5, "nor faint") [Collapsing in despair]
 - 1. By Getting Angry with God saying, "I cannot do anything."
 - 2. By Giving Up while doubting God even cares
- 2. Two Proofs in Discipline (He.12:6-8)
 - **A. It Proves His Love (v.6**, "whom the Lord loves He chastens")
 - B. It Proves Our Sonship (v.6, "and scourges every son whom He receives"; v.7-8)
- 3. Two Products in Discipline (He.12:9-11)
 - A. Results in Life (v,9, "Shall we not much more readily be in subjection to the Father of spirits and live")
 - **B. Results in Holiness (v.10**, "For they indeed for a few days chastened us as seemed best to them, but He For our profit, that we may be partakers of His holiness")
