

# HEBREWS 7–10 OVERVIEW

Hebrews chapters 7-10 contrasts the Old Covenant and New Covenant. In particular, they contrast the priesthood, the Covenants, and the sacrifices including the heavenly sanctuary. This chart is a good overview of these biblical concepts used in the book of Hebrews.
