THE WORD 'PERFECT' IN THE BOOK OF HEBREWS

The book of Hebrews uses the word "perfect" 14 times. The Greek word is *teleios* and means complete, to make perfect by reaching an intended goal, and to bring to a full end. For believers we have a "perfect" standing in Jesus Christ. Plus we are in the process of becoming more in the image of Jesus Christ through sanctification (CI.1:28; 1Th.3:13).
