

# PSALM 110 — NEW TESTAMENT REFERENCES

The New Testament contains more references to Psalm 110 than to any other chapter in the Old Testament. It is used to demonstrate Christ's deity as well as his priesthood.

📖<sup>42</sup>saying, "What do you think about the Christ? Whose Son is He?" They said to Him, "The Son of David."<sup>43</sup>He said to them, "How then does David in the Spirit call Him 'LORD,' saying: <sup>44</sup>THE LORD SAID TO MY LORD, "SIT AT MY RIGHT HAND, TILL I MAKE YOUR ENEMIES YOUR FOOTSTOOL" ' ? " (Mt.22:42-44)

📖<sup>35</sup>Then Jesus answered and said, while He taught in the temple, "How is it that the scribes say that the Christ is the Son of David? <sup>36</sup>For David himself said by the Holy Spirit: 'THE LORD SAID TO MY LORD, "SIT AT MY RIGHT HAND, TILL I MAKE YOUR ENEMIES YOUR FOOTSTOOL.'" <sup>37</sup>Therefore David himself calls Him 'LORD'; how is He then his Son?" And the common people heard Him gladly." (Mk.12:35-37)

📖<sup>42</sup>Now David himself said in the Book of Psalms: 'THE LORD SAID TO MY LORD, " SIT AT MY RIGHT HAND, <sup>43</sup>TILL I MAKE YOUR ENEMIES YOUR FOOTSTOOL.'" <sup>44</sup>Therefore David calls Him 'LORD'; how is He then his Son?" (Lk.20:42-44)

📖"Jesus said to him, "It is as you said. Nevertheless, I say to you, hereafter you will see the Son of Man sitting at the right hand of the Power, and coming on the clouds of heaven."" (Mt.26:64)

"<sup>1</sup>A Psalm of David. The LORD said to my Lord, "Sit at My right hand, Till I make Your enemies Your footstool." <sup>2</sup>The LORD shall send the rod of Your strength out of Zion. Rule in the midst of Your enemies! <sup>3</sup>our people shall be volunteers In the day of Your power; In the beauties of holiness, from the womb of the morning, You have the dew of Your youth. <sup>4</sup>The LORD has sworn And will not relent, "You are a priest forever According to the order of Melchizedek." <sup>5</sup>The Lord is at Your right hand; He shall execute kings in the day of His wrath. <sup>6</sup>He shall judge among the nations, He shall fill the places with dead bodies, He shall execute the heads of many countries. <sup>7</sup>He shall drink of the brook by the wayside; Therefore He shall lift up the head. " (Psalm 110)

📖"Looking unto Jesus, the author and finisher of our faith, who for the joy that was set before Him endured the cross, despising the shame, and has sat down at the right hand of the throne of God." (He.12:2)

📖<sup>12</sup>But this Man, after He had offered one sacrifice for sins forever, sat down at the right hand of God, <sup>13</sup>from that time waiting till His enemies are made His footstool." (He.10:12-13)

📖"Jesus said, "I am. And you will see the Son of Man sitting at the right hand of the Power, and coming with the clouds of heaven."" (Mk.14:62)

📖"Hereafter the Son of Man will sit on the right hand of the power of God." (Lk.22:69)

📖"Who is he who condemns? It is Christ who died, and furthermore is also risen, who is even at the right hand of God, who also makes intercession for us." (Rm.8:34)

📖"For He must reign till He has put all enemies under His feet." (1Co.15:25)

📖"So then, after the Lord had spoken to them, He was received up into heaven, and sat down at the right hand of God." (Mk.16:19)

📖<sup>34</sup>"For David did not ascend into the heavens, but he says himself: 'THE LORD SAID TO MY LORD, "SIT AT MY RIGHT HAND, <sup>35</sup>TILL I MAKE YOUR ENEMIES YOUR FOOTSTOOL.'" (Ac.2:34-35)

📖"which He worked in Christ when He raised Him from the dead and seated Him at His right hand in the heavenly places," (Ep.1:20)

📖"If then you were raised with Christ, seek those things which are above, where Christ is, sitting at the right hand of God." (Cl.3:1)

📖"who being the brightness of His glory and the express image of His person, and upholding all things by the word of His power, when He had by Himself purged our sins, sat down at the right hand of the Majesty on high," (He.1:3)

📖"But to which of the angels has He ever said: "SIT AT MY RIGHT HAND, TILL I MAKE YOUR ENEMIES YOUR FOOTSTOOL"?" (He.1:13)

📖"As He also says in another place: "YOU ARE A PRIEST FOREVER ACCORDING TO THE ORDER OF MELCHIZEDEK"" (He.5:6)

📖<sup>17</sup>For He testifies: "YOU ARE A PRIEST FOREVER ACCORDING TO THE ORDER OF MELCHIZEDEK." <sup>21</sup>(for they have become priests without an oath, but He with an oath by Him who said to Him: "THE LORD HAS SWORN AND WILL NOT RELENT, 'YOU ARE A PRIEST FOREVER ACCORDING TO THE ORDER OF MELCHIZEDEK' ")," (He.7:17,21)

📖"Now this is the main point of the things we are saying: We have such a High Priest, who is seated at the right hand of the throne of the Majesty in the heavens," (He.8:1)
