UNBELIEVER'S RELATIONSHIP TO SIN

Spiritual realities are, in many respects paradoxical to logic and reason, but are nevertheless true. Faith must be the basis for understanding and embracing these truths.

1. Adam died the day he disobeyed God

- At the FALL God said, "You shall not eat it, nor shall you touch it, lest you die" (Ge.3:3).
- They did not die physically. They did die spiritually (spirit died). [See 1Co.15:21-22, 45-47; Ro.5:17]

2. Adam's new corrupt nature is passed on to all humanity as a Representative Head

- "For as by one man's disobedience many were made sinners, so also by one Man's obedience many will be made righteous" (Ro.5:19)
- "Therefore, just as through one man sin entered the world, and death through sin, and thus death spread to all men, because all sinned" (R0.5:12)

3. Because of the sin nature all men personally sin

• "for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God" (Ro.3:23).

Describes the moral state of man: Man has a sinful nature that comes from our parents.

Man's Sinful Nature (Corruption)

Leads to Personal Sin

Romans 5:12

Describes the manifestation of individual's sinful nature: Disobedience of God's will.

Inherit Sin

Because of Transgressions that come from the sinful nature

Romans 3:23

Describes man's legal standing before God: Guilty of sin because of Adam's Original Sin.




