4 ATTITUDES TOWARD THE WILL OF GOD

JAMES 4:13-17

ATTITUDE 1:

PRACTICAL ATHEISM

Foolishness of IGNORING God's Will (v.13-14)

You can just live ignoring it as if there were no God at all

- What makes this planning w/o God so foolish is IGNORANCE
- What makes this planning w/o God so foolish is you are FRAGILE

ATTITUDE 2:

SELF-THEISM

Foolishness of arrogance in DEMEANING (v.16) (denying) God's will

You could acknowledge there is a God, but that your will is supreme to His will

ATTITUDE 3:

CHOOSING DISOBEDIENCE

Foolishness of DISOBEYING God's Will (v.17)

You can acknowledge there is a God whose will is supreme and just not do it

ATTITUDE 4:

BELIEVER'S OBEDIENCE

Blessing of ACKNOWLEDGING and OBEYING God's Will (v.15)

You acknowledge and obey the will of God which brings blessing
