The behavior is changed as a result (8:4) Chapter 7 says, "I have a new will and a <u>new</u> <u>desire</u>." Chapter 8 says, "I have a <u>new behavior</u>." 	 How you behave is the proof of what you really believe and whether or not you've been regenerated. Regeneration, a profound miracle of God, can not be hidden. 	 The Pharisees were hypocritical. They were into religion like few people who have ever lived. They cleansed the outside of the cup but inside is full of filth. They white washed the tombs but inside are full of the stench of death. 	 Parable of the 10 Virgins, 5 wise and 5 foolish. The wise had oil in their lamps, the foolish did not. The foolish had a form of religion, but were not saved.
