## **Works Not Before Salvation**

"For by grace you have been saved through faith, and that not of yourselves; it is the gift of God, ont of works, lest anyone should boast." (**Ep.2:8-9**)

"Therefore by the <u>deeds of the law</u> no flesh will be justified in His sight, for by the law is the knowledge of sin.

28 Therefore we conclude that a man is justified by faith apart from the <u>deeds of the law</u>." (**Rm.3:20,28**)

"And if by grace, then it is <u>no longer of works</u>; otherwise grace is no longer grace. But if it is of works, it is <u>no longer grace</u>; otherwise work is no longer work." (**Rm.11:6**)

"knowing that a man is not justified by the <u>works of the law</u> but by faith in Jesus Christ, even we have believed in Christ Jesus, that we might be justified by faith in Christ and not by the <u>works of the law</u>; for by the works of the law no flesh shall be justified." (**Ga.2:16**)

"who has saved us and called us with a holy calling, <u>not</u> according to <u>our works</u>, but according to His own purpose and grace which was given to us in Christ Jesus before time began" (**2Tm.1:9**)

(Rm.3:27; 4:6; 9:11)

## **Works After Salvation**

- "For we are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand that we should walk in them" (**Ep.2:10**)
- "I, therefore, the prisoner of the Lord, beseech you to walk worthy of the calling with which you were called" (**Ep.4:1**)
- "that you may <u>walk worthy</u> of the Lord, fully pleasing Him, being fruitful in every good work and increasing in the knowledge of God" (Cl.1:10)
- "comfort your hearts and establish you in <u>every good</u> word and work." (2Th.2:17)
- "that the man of God may be complete, thoroughly equipped for every good work" (2Tm.3:17)
- "in all things showing yourself to be a <u>pattern of good</u> works; in doctrine showing integrity, reverence, incorruptibility, "who gave Himself for us, that He might redeem us from every <u>lawless deed</u> and purify for Himself His own special people, <u>zealous for good works</u>." (**Ti.2:7,14**)
- "This is a faithful saying, and these things I want you to affirm constantly, that those who have believed in God should be careful to maintain good works. These things are good and profitable to men" (Ti.3:8)
- "And let us consider one another in order to <u>stir up love</u> and good works" (**He.10:24**)
