MESSAGE FOR US

- In effect Peter was teaching there were two bodies of Christ, one Jewish, and one Gentile. This is heresy!
- Why did Peter compromise? He did not change his theology. He gave in to fear. Fearing people is a dangerous trap (Pr.29:25; Mt.10:26-28)
- If Peter was free to live outside the Law, why can't the Gentiles do the same (Ga.2:14)?
