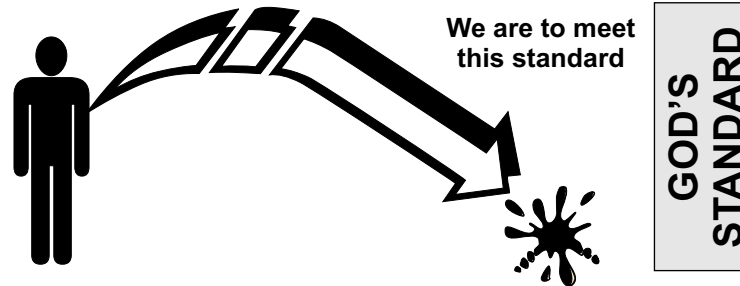


SIN

ACT

- All unrighteousness (1Jn.3:4).
- Whatever is not of faith is sin (Rm.14:23).
- A lack of conformity to the will of God.

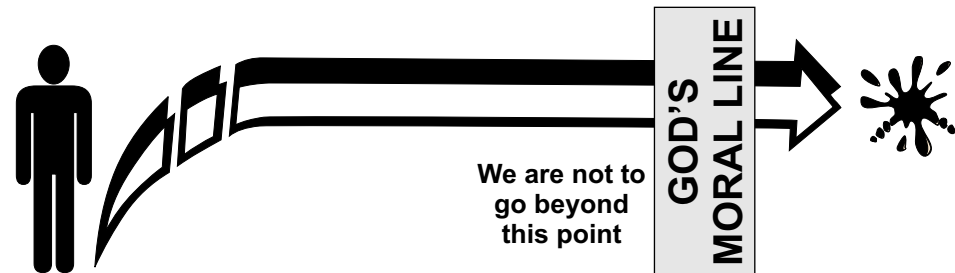


TRANSGRESSION

To Go Beyond A Known Line

REBELLION

- Crosses a line.
- To choose to intentionally disobey.
- Breaking of a known law.



INIQUITY

A Premeditated Choice

TWISTED

- It is to continue without repentance. You encourage others to do the same.
- Left unchecked leads to a state of willful sin with no fear of God.
- The build-up of unrepentant sin is sometimes pictured as a “cup of iniquity” being filled to the brim (Rv.17:4; Ge.15:16).
- This often applies to nations who have forsaken God completely.
- Continued iniquity leads to unnatural affections resulting in a reprobate mind (Rm.1:28-32).
