# 1 JOHN 1:3-10 — FELLOWSHIP

³that which we have seen and heard we declare to you, that you also may have <u>fellowship</u> with us; and truly our <u>fellowship</u> is with the Father and with His Son Jesus Christ. ⁴And these things we write to you that your joy may be full. ⁵This is the message which we have heard from Him and declare to you, that God is light and in Him is no darkness at all. ⁴If we say that we have <u>fellowship</u> with Him, and walk in darkness, we lie and do not practice the truth. ¹But if we walk in the light as He is in the light, we have <u>fellowship</u> with one another, and the blood of Jesus Christ His Son cleanses us from all sin. ³If we say that we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us. ¹If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness. ¹If we say that we have not sinned, we make Him a liar, and His word is not in us. (1 John 1:3-10)



### THE BASIS OF FELLOWSHIP — SALVATION

GOD takes care of the basis of fellowship

- No believer is ever out of fellowship. If you were out of fellowship you would not be saved (1Jn.1:6-7).
- Our fellowship is eternal, and the blood of Christ always cleanses all our sin. Believers confess their sin (1Jn.1:9).

- THE DANGER TO FELLOWSHIP SIN GOD takes care of the sin problem

## **RESPONSIBILITIES OF FELLOWSHIP**

WE are responsible for our fellowship among believers

### INDIVIDUAL RESPONSIBILITIES

- 1. Confess our trespasses one to another (**Ja.5:16**) 4. We are to rebuke sin in one another (**Ep.5:11; 1Tm.5:20**)
- 2. We must forgive one another (2Co.2:6-8; Cl.3:13) 5. We are to restore a sinning brother (Ga.6:1)
- 3. We must bear one another's burdens (**Ga.6:2**) 6. We are to take special care for the weaker brother (**1Th.5:14**)

#### **CHURCH RESPONSIBILITIES**

1. We are to apply Church Discipline when necessary (1Co.5:5; 1Tm.1:20; Mt.18:15-20)
