5 ASPECTS OF PROPITIATION — 1 JOHN 2:2

¹My little children, these things I write to you, so that you may not sin. And if anyone sins, we have an Advocate with the Father, Jesus Christ the righteous. ²And He Himself is the propitiation for our sins, and not for ours only but also for the whole world (1Jn.2:1-2).

1. The NATURE of Propitiation

SATISFACTION

"He Himself is the propitiation for our sins" (1Jn.2:2)

* The NATURE of propitiation is to bring a sacrifice that satisfies God's holy justice.

2. The NECESSITY of Propitiation

SIN

"Also for the whole world" (1Jn.2:2)

The NECESSITY of propitiation is because of sin. All sin must be paid for.

3. The AGENT of Propitiation

"He Himself is the propitiation" (1Jn.2:2)

"Jesus Christ the righteous" (1Jn.2:1)

PROPITIATION

REMOVAL OF

* The AGENT of propitiation must Himself be righteous. Jesus alone is righteous.

4. The MOTIVE of Propitiation

LOVE

JESUS

"but that He loved us and sent His Son to be the propitiation" (1Jn.4:10)

The MOTIVE of propitiation was the love of the Father who sent His Son.

5. The EXTENT of Propitiation

WORLD

"not for ours only but also for the whole world" (1Jn.2:2)

The EXTENT of propitiation goes beyond the nation of Israel, even to the world.
