### ASSURANCE ELEMENTS — 1JOHN 2:3-6

<sup>3</sup>Now by this <u>we know that we know</u> Him, if we keep His commandments. <sup>4</sup>He who says, "I know Him," and does not keep His commandments, is a liar, and the truth is not in him. <sup>5</sup>But whoever keeps His word, truly the love of God is perfected in him. By this we know that we are in Him. <sup>6</sup>He who says he abides in Him ought himself also to walk just as He walked. (1 John 2:3-6)

### 1. COGNITIVE ASSURANCE

**MIND** 

• Cognitive assurance of salvation comes right out of the promises of Scripture.

**INTERNAL** 

• It starts in the mind and is rational. Assurance runs parallel with faith.

W.O.G.

• This is not perfect assurance (Mk.9:24, "Lord, I believe; help my unbelief!"; Lk.17:5, "increase our faith").

# 2. SUBJECTIVE ASSURANCE

**EMOTIONS** 

**ADOPTION** - Being led by the Spirit is spiritual, not of a material nature

**INTERNAL** 

• Romans 8:16, "The Spirit Himself bears witness with our spirit that we are children of God"

H.S.

• As you study the Word of God, the Spirit bears witness through the promises of Scripture that you are His child.

#### **CONVICTION** - Conviction is another way the Holy Spirit leads us

• The Spirit gives us that sense of conviction on the inside to guard from external pressures (2Co.1:12).

#### **CHASTENING** - He corrects us because He loves us

- The Lord will bring things into our lives to "nudge" and correct us to get us back onto the right path. This brings assurance (**He.12:5-6**).
- He corrects us because we are His children. He does not do this for the unbeliever. The unbeliever is always on the wrong path. Unbelievers need to be reborn, not reformed.

# 3. BEHAVIORAL ASSURANCE

**ACTIONS** 

• "Let us draw near with a true heart in full assurance of faith, having our hearts sprinkled from an evil conscience and our bodies washed with pure water" (He.10:22)

EXTERNAL **WALK** 

- There is no assurance of salvation without sanctification (**He.10:22**). This is a moral test (**1Jn.2:3**).
- Where there is in your life a lack of sanctification, there will be with it a lack of assurance.

All of these contribute to a FULL ASSURANCE (He.10:22)
