

1,000 YEARS Rv.20:1-7

THOSE WITH GLORIFIED BODIES

- The church and OT saints via Rapture (1Th.4:13-18; Da.12:1-2)
- Those resurrected after Christ comes to the earth (Rv.20:4-6)

THOSE WITH EARTHLY BODIES

- Believing Jews (144,000 plus 70th Week converts)
- Believing Gentiles (Mt.25:31-46, "sheep")

ALL WHO ENTER THE KINGDOM WILL BE BELIEVERS

Now I saw a new heaven and a new earth, for the first heaven and the first earth had passed away. Also there was no more sea.

"new heaven and a new earth... first earth had passed away" (Rv.21:1) "new heaven...new earth"

- This explains why John sees a new heaven and earth at this point. The first heaven and earth "passed away".
- This appears to refer to the final destruction of the present earth.
- There will be a restored creation no longer affected by sin (Ac.3:21; Ro.8:21).

"there was no more sea" (Rv.21:1) "there was no more sea"

- The vision described by John in Revelation 21:1 must follow the temporal kingdom.
- The absence of the sea, but the presence of a new heaven and earth signals a difference between this period and the kingdom period.
- This is not as much a <u>period of time</u> as it is a <u>location</u>. That is: (1) <u>earth</u> and (2) <u>New Jerusalem</u>.
- The sea is present during the kingdom on the earth.

Then I, John, saw the holy city, New Jerusalem, coming down out of heaven from God, prepared as a bride adorned for her husband.

And I heard a loud voice from heaven saying, "Behold, the tabernacle of God is with men, and He will dwell with them, and they shall be His people. God Himself will be with them and be their God.

REVELATION 21:3

"God Himself will be with them and be their God" (Rv.21:3)



"be their God"





"My tabernacle also shall be with them; indeed I will be their God, and they shall be My people (**Ek.37:27**)



And God will wipe away every tear from their eyes; there shall be no more <u>death</u>, nor <u>sorrow</u>, nor crying. There shall be no more pain, for the former things have passed away."

"there shall be no... crying" (Rv.21:4)



"death...crying"

- The cessation of weeping and mourning is a promise (Is 35:10, 65:19) finally realized.
- The New Jerusalem occupants will not experience "death".
- But on the earth during the Millennial Kingdom there are those who will die (Is.65:20).
- The things that produced hardship and suffering for mankind have been removed.

Then He who sat on the throne said, "Behold, I make all things new." And He said to me, "Write, for these words are true and faithful."

"He who sat on the throne...these words are true and faithful" (Rv.21:5)



"true and faithful"

- This is one of the few direct references to the Father in the Revelation. The Father speaks.
- These words apply to the whole book of Revelation, not just this section.

And He said to me, "It is done! I am the Alpha and the Omega, the Beginning and the End. I will give of the fountain of the water of life freely to him who thirsts.

"Alpha and the Omega" (Rv.21:6)



- The first and last letters of the Greek alphabet, so beginning and end.
- The phrase focuses on the absolute power and sovereignty of God.
- What is "done!" is not indicated. These are likely referring to God's promises being fulfilled.
- The fountain of water is a pictural way of referring to eternal life.

He who overcomes shall inherit all things, and I will be his God and he shall be My son.

REVELATION 21:7

"He who overcomes shall inherit" (Rv.21:7)



"overcomes"

- The overcomer gets all the things listed above. The overcomer is the <u>one that believes on Jesus</u>.
- Overcomers will be adopted as "sons" of God.
- All the <u>rights and privileges of sonship</u> come with this promise.
- This is beyond human comprehension.


But the cowardly, unbelieving, abominable, murderers, sexually immoral, sorcerers, idolaters, and all liars shall have their part in the lake which burns with fire and brimstone, which is the second death.

REVELATION 21:8

"the second death" (Rv.21:8) "the second death"

- "the second death" refers to the end of the 1,000-year kingdom.
- This is a <u>summary</u> of a <u>future event</u>.
- The righteous become part of the family of God the Father, but the wicked receive eternal punishment.

"Come, I will show you the bride, the Lamb's wife" (Rv.21:9)



"the bride... Lamb's wife"

- This is <u>not an advancement</u> of the chronology of the book.
- "seven angels who had the seven bowls." This is at the start of the Millennium otherwise why mention this angel associated with the last plagues?
- This is the <u>first of seven</u> references to the <u>Lamb</u> in this section (Rv.21:9,14, 22-23, 27, 22:1,3).

"Come, I will show you the bride, the Lamb's wife" (Rv.21:9)



"the bride... Lamb's wife"

- In Revelation 19, the wife of the Lamb consists of believers.
- In Revelation 21, the wife of the Lamb is the New Jerusalem.
- It is quite clear that the "bride," the wife of the Lamb, is the New Jerusalem (Rv.21:10).
- The New Jerusalem is a city. It is not just a person or a group of people.





And he carried me away in the Spirit to a great and high mountain, and showed me the great city, the holy Jerusalem, descending out of heaven from God,

REVELATION 21:10

"high mountain...holy Jerusalem" (Rv.21:10)



"holy Jerusalem"

- The "high mountain" must refer to John's day because all mountains are removed (Rv.16:20).
- The city appears to be suspended over the earth.
- The "holy Jerusalem" is in contrast with mystery Babylon (Rv.17, Jerusalem) which had the glory of man.

MILLENNIAL KINGDOM

- Christ will rule as king (Is.9:3-7; 11:1-10).
- Nobles and governors will also rule (Is.32:1; Mt.19:28)
- Jerusalem will be the political center of the world (Zc.8:3)
- God will fulfill His promises to Israel, the Church, the Nations, Creation, and His Son.

Great White Throne Judgment for ALL unbelievers. All sent to Lake of Fire

New Heavens and New Earth destroyed by fire (2Pe.3:10; Mt.24:35) and remade (Rv.21-22; 1Co.15:35-58)

ETERNAL STATE

Wicked Dead Raised (Rv.20:5-6)

Battle: Gog & Magog (Rv.20:7-9)

- Satan will deceive the unbelievers and gather an army to march against Jesus and Israel
- The ensuing battle will be short-lived. Satan will be thrown into the lake of fire and his human army killed (Rv.20:7-10)

having the glory of God. Her light was like a most precious stone, like a jasper stone, clear as crystal.

Also she had a great and high wall with twelve gates, and twelve angels at the gates, and names written on them, which are the names of the twelve tribes of the children of Israel:

REVELATION 21:12

"high wall with twelve gates" (Rv.21:12)



"twelve gates"

- The "gates" had 12 angels at each of the 12 gates.
- The 12 gates had the names of the 12 tribes of Israel.
- Each tribe has access to the city. Israel will have her promised restoration.

three gates on the east, three gates on the north, three gates on the south, and three gates on the west.

REVELATION 21:13

Now the wall of the city had twelve foundations, and on them were the names of the twelve apostles of the Lamb.

"twelve apostles" (Rv.21:14)



"twelve apostles"

Meanwhile on the earth presiding over the those on the earth including the twelve tribes of Israel will be King David (Ek.34:23-24, 37:24-25).



"23 will establish one shepherd over them, and he shall feed them—My servant David. He shall feed them and be their shepherd. 24 And I, the LORD, will be their God, and My servant David a prince among them; I, the LORD, have spoken. (**Ek.34:23-24**)

And he who talked with me had a gold reed to measure the city, its gates, and its wall.

"a gold reed to measure... city... gates... walls" (Rv.21:15)



"reed to measure"

- The "reed" was about 10 feet long.
- The capital of heaven belongs to God and He is measuring what is His.
 - Ek.40:3, Ezekiel's temple measured
 - Rv.11:1, Tribulation temple measured

The city is laid out as a square; its length is as great as its breadth. And he measured the city with the reed: twelve thousand furlongs. Its length, breadth, and height are equal.

"The city is laid out as a square" (Rv.21:16)



"square"

- Commentators differ as to whether the city is a <u>cube</u> or a <u>pyramid</u>.
- Many see it as a pyramid form. And others see it as a perfect cube.
- Many favor the <u>cube</u> because it was the shape as the Most Holy Place in the Temple (1Ki.6:20).


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

Then he measured its wall: one hundred and forty-four cubits, according to the measure of a man, that is, of an angel.

"wall: one hundred and forty-four cubits" (Rv.21:17)



"wall"

- The width or thickness of the wall is 216 feet or 72 yards.
- So going through the gates must be like going through a <u>tunnel</u>.

The construction of its wall was of jasper; and the city was pure gold, like clear glass.

"city was pure gold, like clear glass" (Rv.21:18)



"like clear glass"

- Unlike earth's gold, this gold will be transparent.
- The overpowering radiance of God's glory can refract and glisten through the entire city.




God's Glory Reflects Throughout the City

The foundations of the wall of the city were adorned with all kinds of precious stones: the first foundation was jasper, the second sapphire, the third chalcedony, the fourth emerald,



the fifth sardonyx, the sixth sardius, the seventh chrysolite, the eighth beryl, the ninth topaz, the tenth chrysoprase, the eleventh jacinth, and the twelfth amethyst.

The twelve gates were twelve pearls: each individual gate was of one pearl. And the street of the city was pure gold, like transparent glass.

"The twelve gates were twelve pearls" (Rv.21:21)



"twelve gates... twelve pearls"

- The twelve gates were twelve pearls; each one of the gates was a single pearl.
- The street of the city was pure gold, like transparent glass.
- The streets cry out praises to God as God's glory shines upon its translucent gold element.



But I saw no temple in it, for the Lord God Almighty and the Lamb are its temple.

"the Lord God Almighty and the Lamb are its temple" (Rv.21:22)



"no temple"

- In the New Jerusalem there will not be a temple. But there will be Ezekiel's temple on the earth in old Jerusalem.
- Jewish life without a temple will certainly be different.
- The shadows of the temple is replaced with reality.
- Instead of God being housed in a building, the building is housed in God.

The city had no need of the sun or of the moon to shine in it, for the glory of God illuminated it. The Lamb is its light.

"no need of the sun...glory of God" (Rv.21:23)



"no need of the sun"

- The New Jerusalem will not need natural light sources such as the sun or moon.
- This is not referring to the eternal state. In the eternal state there will be a sun and moon.
- The glory of God illumines the New Jerusalem.

And the nations of those who are saved shall walk in its light, and the kings of the earth bring their glory and honor into it.

"nations of those who are saved" (Rv.21:24)



"walk in its light"

- "The Lamb is its light". This dwelling place remains in the air, to cast its light, which is the shining of the brilliance of the Son.
- The glory and honor of the nations will be in the city.
- The light from the New Jerusalem will shine upon the earth so the "kings of the earth" can be guided.

Its gates shall not be shut at all by day (there shall be no night there).

"there shall be no night there" (Rv.21:25)



"gates shall not be shut"

- Because God's glory will be present continually there will be no night there.
- The absence of night would also mean no need for sleep.
- The gates are never close indicating complete safety.

And they shall bring the glory and the honor of the nations into it.

"honor of the nations" (Rv.21:26)



"nations"

Only believers are permitted into the New Jerusalem.

So these people "of the nations" are saved.

But there shall by no means enter it anything that defiles, or causes an abomination or a lie, but only those who are written in the Lamb's Book of Life.

"there shall by no means enter it anything that defiles" (Rv.21:27)



"anything that defiles"

- This description will only make sense when there will be mortals on the earth.
- There will be sinners during the Millennium. They will not be able to enter the New Jerusalem.
- This verse would not make sense during the eternal state. During the eternal state, there are no sinners.




