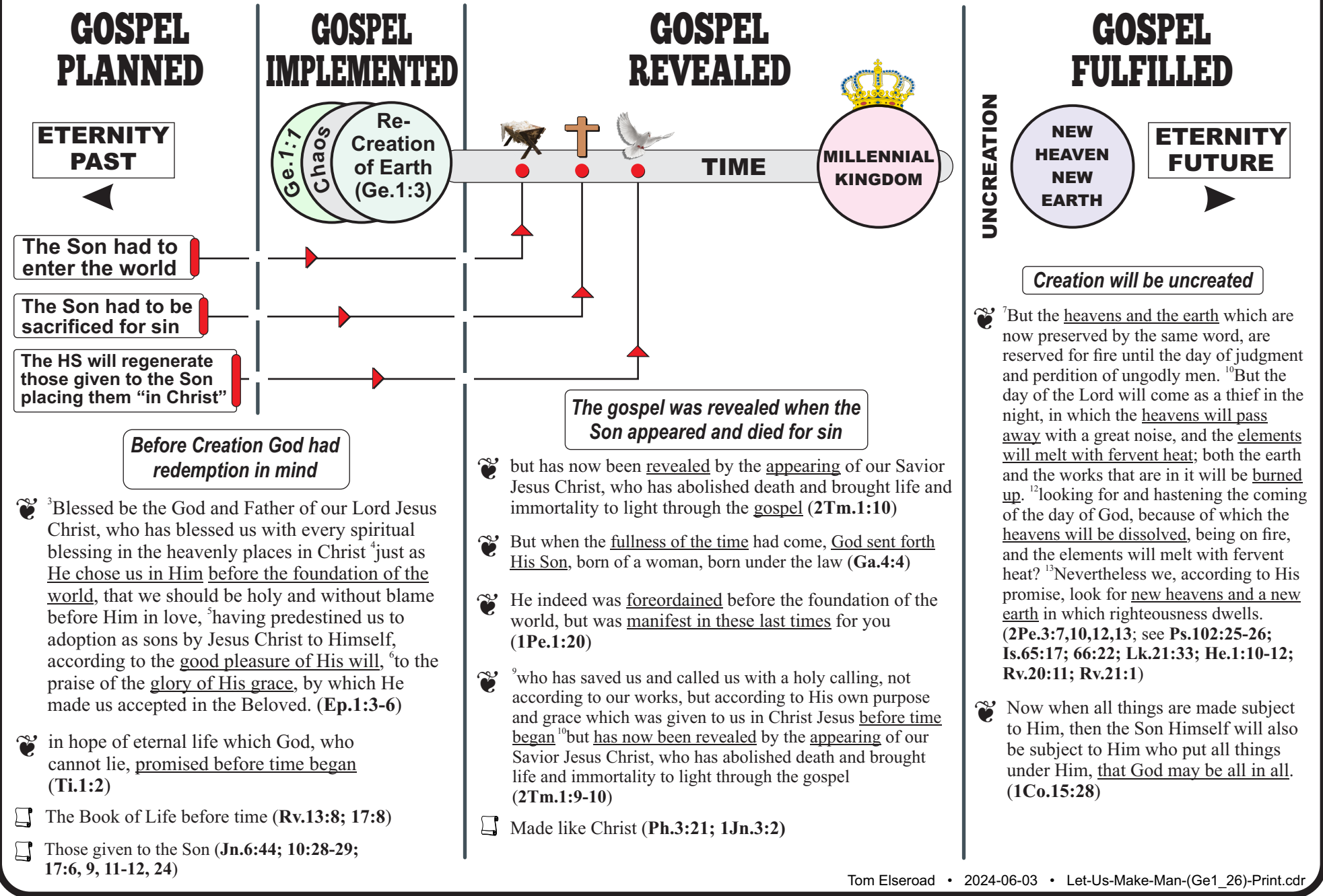


CREATION UNTO REDEMPTION

⁷in hope of eternal life which God, who cannot lie, promised before time began (Ti.1:2)

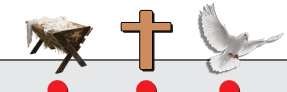

GOSPEL REVEALED



TIME



The gospel was revealed when the Son appeared and died for sin

- ¹⁰but has now been revealed by the appearing of our Savior Jesus Christ, who has abolished death and brought life and immortality to light through the gospel (2Tm.1:10)
- ¹¹But when the fullness of the time had come, God sent forth His Son, born of a woman, born under the law (Ga.4:4)
- ¹²He indeed was foreordained before the foundation of the world, but was manifest in these last times for you (1Pe.1:20)
- ¹³who has saved us and called us with a holy calling, not according to our works, but according to His own purpose and grace which was given to us in Christ Jesus before time began ¹⁴but has now been revealed by the appearing of our Savior Jesus Christ, who has abolished death and brought life and immortality to light through the gospel (2Tm.1:9-10)
- ¹⁵Made like Christ (Ph.3:21; 1Jn.3:2)

Creation will be uncreated

¹⁶But the heavens and the earth which are now preserved by the same word, are reserved for fire until the day of judgment and perdition of ungodly men. ¹⁷But the day of the Lord will come as a thief in the night, in which the heavens will pass away with a great noise, and the elements will melt with fervent heat; both the earth and the works that are in it will be burned up. ¹⁸looking for and hastening the coming of the day of God, because of which the heavens will be dissolved, being on fire, and the elements will melt with fervent heat? ¹⁹Nevertheless we, according to His promise, look for new heavens and a new earth in which righteousness dwells. (2Pe.3:7,10,12,13; see Ps.102:25-26; Is.65:17; 66:22; Lk.21:33; He.1:10-12; Rv.20:11; Rv.21:1)

²⁰Now when all things are made subject to Him, then the Son Himself will also be subject to Him who put all things under Him, that God may be all in all. (1Co.15:28)
