- Satan wants you to believe that he is telling you the truth, and that God is a liar.
- The deadliest force released upon the world is the assumption that what God said is subject to our judgment or opinion. Satan always lies saying there will be no judgment ('You will not die').

3 The SEDUCTIO

"So when the woman saw that the tree was good for food, that it was pleasant to the eyes, and a tree desirable to make one wise..." (Ge.3:6a)

- We have an unbelieving thought and we let that thought begin to seduce us through our lust (Ja.1:14-15).
- Now it is working on her emotions.

- ... she took of its fruit and ate. She also gave to her husband with her, and he ate." (Ge.3:6b)
 - Now self-satisfaction drives her. It is no longer the glory of God anymore.
