## NOAH AND THE GREAT FLOOD

Wickedness increased on the earth (**Ge.6:5**), so God determined to destroy the human race except for the few people He extended His grace toward. There are two reasons given for the flood: (1) the sins of the sons of God (**Ge.6:1-4**), and (2) the sins of humankind (**Ge.6:5-8**). The deluge came from rain falling and water erupting from under the earth (**Ge.7:11**). The ark was planned by God and was His invention, not man's. The fact of the flood is (1) provided by the Genesis account, and (2) stated by Christ Himself (**Mt.24:37-39**; **Lk.17:26-27**), and (3) by the Apostles (**1Pe.3:20**; **2Pe.2:5**; **3:6**). Around the world the historical stories of a world-wide flood, even between peoples who could not have had contact, is quite evident. To deny a universal flood demonstrates an obvious bias.

If we count the year of Adam's Creation as year 1, then Noah was born in the year 1056.
