NOAH AND THE GREAT FLOOD TIMELINE

Wickedness increased on the earth (Ge.6:5), so God determined to destroy the human race except for the few people He extended His grace toward. The reason for the Flood relates to the ongoing corruption and rebellion of mankind (Ge.6:5-8) The deluge came from rain falling and water erupting from under the earth (Ge.7:11). The ark was planned by God and was His invention, not man's. The fact of the flood is (1) provided by the Genesis account, and (2) stated by Christ Himself (Mt.24:37-39; Lk.17:26-27), and (3) by the Apostles (1Pe.3:20; 2Pe.2:5; 3:6). Around the world the historical stories of a world-wide flood, even between peoples who could not have had contact, is quite evident. To deny a universal flood demonstrates an obvious bias.
