
CREATION UNTO REDEMPTION



- Christ, who has blessed us with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly places in Christ ⁴just as He chose us in Him before the foundation of the world, that we should be holy and without blame before Him in love, 5 having predestined us to adoption as sons by Jesus Christ to Himself, according to the good pleasure of His will, 6to the praise of the glory of His grace, by which He made us accepted in the Beloved. (Ep.1:3-6)
- in hope of eternal life which God, who cannot lie, promised before time began (Ti.1:2)
- The Book of Life before time (Rv.13:8: 17:8)
- Those given to the Son (Jn.6:44; 10:28-29; 17:6, 9, 11-12, 24)

- But when the <u>fullness of the time</u> had come, <u>God sent forth</u> His Son, born of a woman, born under the law (Ga.4:4)
- He indeed was <u>foreordained</u> before the foundation of the world, but was manifest in these last times for you (1Pe.1:20)
- ⁹who has saved us and called us with a holy calling, not according to our works, but according to His own purpose and grace which was given to us in Christ Jesus before time began 10 but has now been revealed by the appearing of our Savior Jesus Christ, who has abolished death and brought life and immortality to light through the gospel (2Tm.1:9-10)
- Made like Christ (**Ph.3:21**; **1Jn.3:2**)

Creation will be uncreated

- But the <u>heavens and the earth</u> which are now preserved by the same word, are reserved for fire until the day of judgment and perdition of ungodly men. ¹⁰But the day of the Lord will come as a thief in the night, in which the heavens will pass away with a great noise, and the elements will melt with fervent heat; both the earth and the works that are in it will be burned up. ¹²looking for and hastening the coming of the day of God, because of which the heavens will be dissolved, being on fire, and the elements will melt with fervent heat? ¹³Nevertheless we, according to His promise, look for new heavens and a new earth in which righteousness dwells. (2Pe.3:7.10.12.13: see Ps.102:25-26: Is.65:17; 66:22; Lk.21:33; He.1:10-12; Rv.20:11; Rv.21:1)
