T o u c h	(14:8) <u>Do Not Touch Their Dead Bodies</u>	
S e a F o o d	(14:9) <u>Must be Both</u> Fins Scales	
I n s e c t s	(14:19) <u>Do Not Eat Winged Insects w/ 4 Legs</u> Exceptions (Le. 11:20-23) Those that jump Locusts (all varieties) including grasshoppers, crickets	Insects have 6 legs. Here it seems to be referring to a 6-legged insect that walks on 4 legs.
M o t h e r ' s	(14:21) <u>Do Not Boil a Young Goat in it's Mother's Milk</u>	We must be careful to avoid everything contrary to nature. Here what is intended as nourishment for life should not be used to take life. (1Co. 11:14).
N a d t e u a r t a h i	(14:21) <u>Do Not Eat Anything that Dies a Natural Death</u>	You can give it to an alien in your town, so he can eat it. You may sell it to a foreigner.
