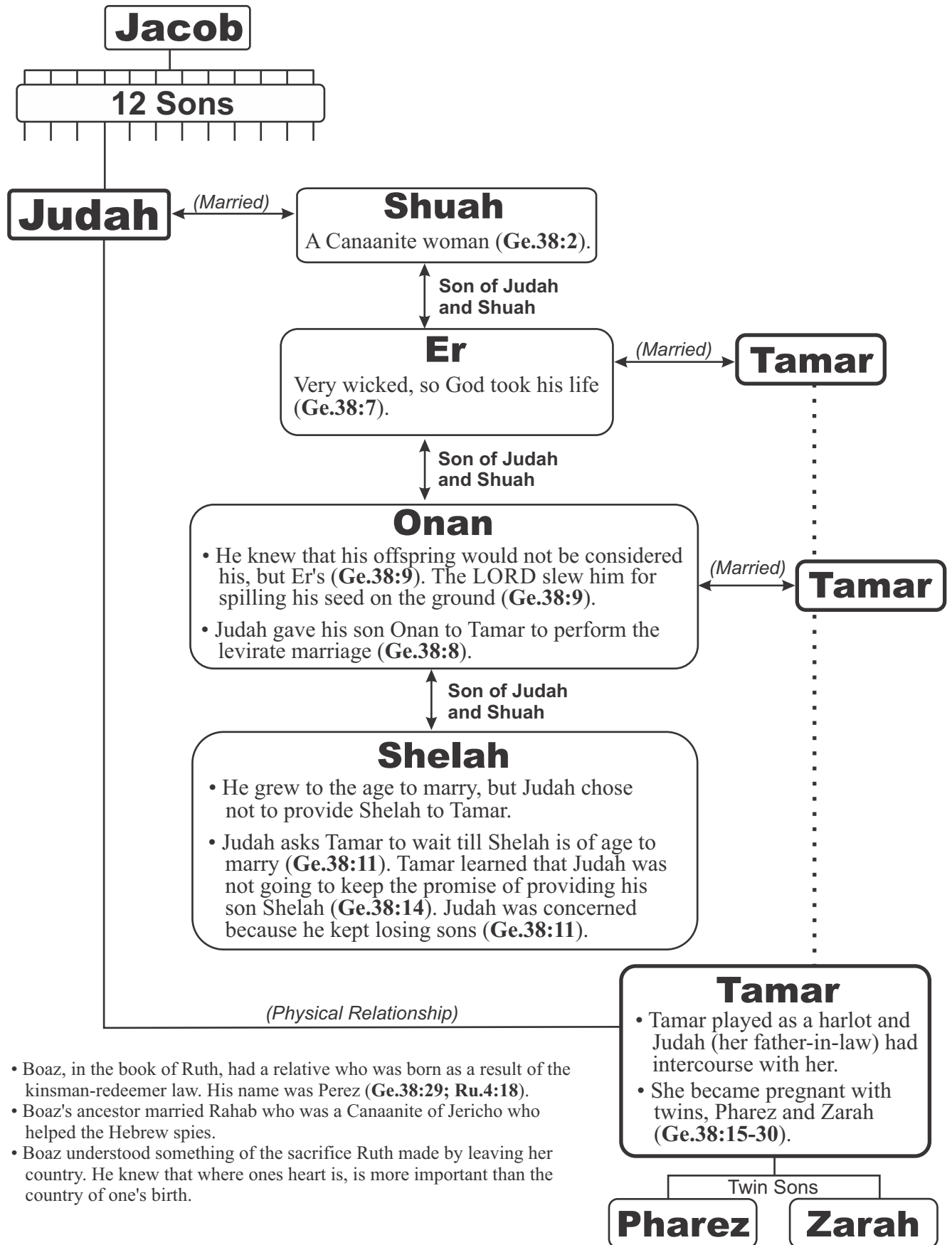


JACOB AND TAMAR — GENESIS 38
