## DANIEL 10-12 INTRODUCTION



Chapters 10-12 are a SINGLE UNIT forming Daniel's Final Vision.



Chapter 10 gives us the BACKDROP for the vision



Chapter 11 gives us the DETAILS of the vision



Chapter 12 is the angelic EXPLANATION of the things described in chapter 11.




- "At that time" refers back to the continuing context of Daniel 11.
- The first "at that time" refers to the start of the persecution/Tribulation.
- This is the time of <u>unparalleled</u> distress for the Jewish people.
- Jesus quotes this verse as still future (Mt.24:21).
- The second "at that time" refers to the end of the 70th Week.





There is a cause and effect action. When Michael "arises" (see the Hebrew and Greek), he is ceasing his ministry, at which time brings about the great persecution against God's people.





Daniel's use of the <u>Hebrew term</u> 'âmad [H5975] comports with the ceasing activity of the restrainer in 2 Thessalonians 2:6–7.

The <u>Greek term anistēmi</u> [G450] in Daniel 12:1 of the Septuagint (LXX) means, "to pass by," which corresponds with the ceasing of restraint in 2 Thessalonians 2:6–7.





- The Restraining Includes the "Mystery of Iniquity" (2Th.2:7)
- Satan Cannot Prevail Against Michael And His Angels (Re.12:8)
- Michael Will "Stand Aside" No Longer Restraining Satan (Da.12:1; 2Th.2:4-7)

### MICHAEL THE ARCHANGEL — RESTRAINER

This restrainer prevents a premature manifestation of the man of sin. It seems likely that Satan would love to have his man come forward, but the restrainer is holding him back. This is done to keep him from revealing himself before the appointed time as determined by God.



## MICHAEL: ISRAEL'S PROTECTOR

12 Then said he unto me, Fear not, Daniel: for from the first day that thou didst set thine heart to understand, and to chasten thyself before thy God, thy words were heard, and I am come for thy words. 13 But the prince of the kingdom of Persia withstood me one and twenty days: but, lo, Michael, one of the chief princes, came to help me; and I remained there with the kings of Persia. 14 Now I am come to make thee understand what shall befall thy people in the latter days: for yet the vision is for many days. 21 But I will shew thee that which is noted in the scripture of truth: and there is none that holdeth with me in these things, but Michael your prince. - We see angels functioning as restrainers in Revelation 9:14-16.
- When the 6th angel blows his trumpet, the 4 restraining angels bound at the river Euphrates are released.
- The result will be 1/3 of earth's population are killed.





### MICHAEL'S MINISTRY CEASES LEADING TO TRIBULATION



The Greek term <u>anistēmi</u> [G450] in Daniel 12:1 of the Septuagint (LXX) means, "to pass by," which corresponds with the ceasing of restraint in 2 Thessalonians 2:6–7.

The state of the



Revelation 12:7–17 supports viewing Michael as the Restrainer because it links the cessation of Michael's war against the dragon with the unprecedented persecution of God's people. This is consistent with Paul (2Th.2:6-7) and Daniel.



Michael's ministry ceases and causes the eschatological temple to be desolate by Antichrist, then followed by the time of tribulation against God's people.

## MICHAEL'S FUTURE IMPORTANCE

His actions of casting out Satan will initiate the final unparalleled persecution of Israel and believers (Da.12:1)

His voice will be heard at the rapture (1Th.4:16, "with the voice of an archangel")

And many of those who sleep in the dust of the earth shall awake, Some to everlasting life, Some to shame and everlasting contempt.

The resurrection is described as taking place "at that time" during the distress (Dan 12:1).



The wording indicates that will take place at some unknown point during the great tribulation, not after the 3.5 year period is completed.



The terror of hell never ends. There is no blissful annihilation after some period of punishment.



Those who are wise shall shine Like the brightness of the firmament, And those who turn many to righteousness Like the stars forever and ever.





This is not only a literal sealing, but it is also a prophetic act, speaking to the fact that this vision would not be fully understood until "the end of time."



That knowledge will increase has the idea of searching after knowledge.



Then I, Daniel, looked; and there stood two others, one on this riverbank and the other on that riverbank.

Daniel is back to the riverbank first mentioned in Da.10:4. The visions of Daniel 10 through 12 have all taken place as Daniel stood at this riverbank.





And one said to the man clothed in linen, who was above the waters of the river, "How long" shall the fulfillment of these wonders be?"

The "how long" question in verse 6 refers back to this statement concerning all of the prophecies that were given to Daniel. They will come to an end no later than the completion of the 3.5 years.



A few verses further, at the completion of the book of Daniel, this is qualified with the statement that there will be an extra 75 days that will follow the 3.5 years.



It is a misinterpretation then to locate the resurrection at the end of the 3.5 years.

Interpreters have traditionally thought that the resurrection will occur at the end of the 3.5 years by assuming that Dan 12:7 is answering the question from verse 6, "How long shall the fulfillment of these wonders be?"



The immediate antecedent in this context shows that it refers to the general summary of all the prophecies in the visions given to Daniel.

- Daniel didn't understand it all either, even though he heard it first hand! Maybe this should comfort us.

Perhaps Daniel asked this question, anxious because he understood just how terrible the time of trouble would be.



And he said, "Go your way, Daniel, for the words are closed up and sealed till the time of the end.

The command to go your way is literally merely "to go" but it is not meant physically.



The angel is telling Daniel to make a mental departure from the questioning. More details would be revealed later; Daniel must be content with what God has revealed thus far.

- The angel is summarizing, and even quoting directly from Daniel 11:33-35 which places it in the end time during the resurrection.
- The angel has now shown that it is speaking of the Antichrist at least back to Daniel 11:33.
- The resurrection will take place before the completion of the 3.5 year period.
- After the wicked is left behind they will continue to act wickedly (Rv.9:20-21).

### DANIEL 10-12 VISION TIMING CONTINUITY

Many shall be purified, made white, and refined, but the wicked shall do wickedly; and none of the wicked shall understand, but the wise shall understand. (Da.12:10)



<sup>33</sup>And those of the people who understand shall instruct many; yet for many days they shall fall by sword and flame, by captivity and plundering. <sup>34</sup>Now when they fall, they shall be aided with a little help; but many shall join with them by intrigue. 35 And some of those of understanding shall fall, to refine them, purify them, and make them white, until the time of the end; because it is still for the appointed time. (Da.11:33-35)

- When the angels are talking and ask WHEN (12:6) are these things going to be completed they quote Da.11:33-35.
- The angels clearly place the events of Da.11:33-35 at the time of the 70th Week.

- The angel is quoting from Daniel 11:31 where "the daily sacrifice is taken away".
- According to the angel's interpretation, the Antichrist is in view all the way back to Daniel 11:31.
- Daniel says that from the time of the abomination of desolation, you can simply start marking off your calendar to the final consummation of all things, 1,290 days later.

### DANIEL 10-12 VISION TIMING CONTINUITY

And from the time that the daily sacrifice is taken away, and the abomination of desolation is set up, there shall be one thousand two hundred and ninety days. (Da.12:11)



And forces shall be mustered by him, and they shall defile the sanctuary fortress; then they shall take away the daily sacrifices, and place there the abomination of desolation. (Da.11:31)



- The angel is still answering the question of WHEN these things will be completed (12:6).
- The angel recalls when the abomination was referred to in Daniel 11:31 to help answer the WHEN question.
- The abomination of Daniel 11:31 takes place in the context of the last days. These
  are not two different events.
- Daniel 11:31 is not one event carried out by Antiochus and then later by Antichrist.
- Jesus does not indicate there are multiple abominations. He refers to one, and that is in the future.

## DANIEL AND FOUR TEMPLES

### 1. By Nebuchadnezzar, in 586 B.C. (9:17)

Dan 9:17 Now therefore, our God, hear the prayer of Your servant, and his supplications, and for the Lord's sake cause Your face to shine on Your sanctuary, which is desolate.

### 2. By Antiochus Epiphanes, in 171-174 B.C. (8:13)

Dan 8:13 Then I heard a holy one speaking; and another holy one said to that certain one who was speaking, "How long will the vision be, concerning the daily sacrifices and the transgression of desolation, the giving of both the sanctuary and the host to be trampled underfoot?"



### 3. By Titus, in 70 A.D. (9:26)

Dan 9:26 "And after the sixty-two weeks Messiah shall be cut off, but not for Himself; And the people of the prince who is to come Shall destroy the city and the <u>sanctuary</u>. The end of it shall be with a flood, And till the end of the war desolations are determined.

### 4. By the Coming Antichrist, During the Great Tribulation (9:27)

Dan 9:27 Then he shall confirm a covenant with many for one week; But in the middle of the week He shall bring an end to sacrifice and offering. And on the wing of abominations shall be one who makes desolate, Even until the consummation, which is determined, Is poured out on the desolate."

Blessed is he who waits, and comes to the one thousand three hundred and thirty-five days.


Forty-five more days, even beyond the 1,290 days, allows for transition between Israel's time of being shattered (Da.12:7) and God's setting up of His kingdom (Da.7:13-14, 27).



Forty-five days after the end of Daniel's 70th Week, Israel's long-awaited blessings will be realized.



The angel said Daniel would "rest" in death (Da.12:2). But he will be resurrected (will rise at the end of the days), and he will receive his allotted inheritance in the Millennium.
