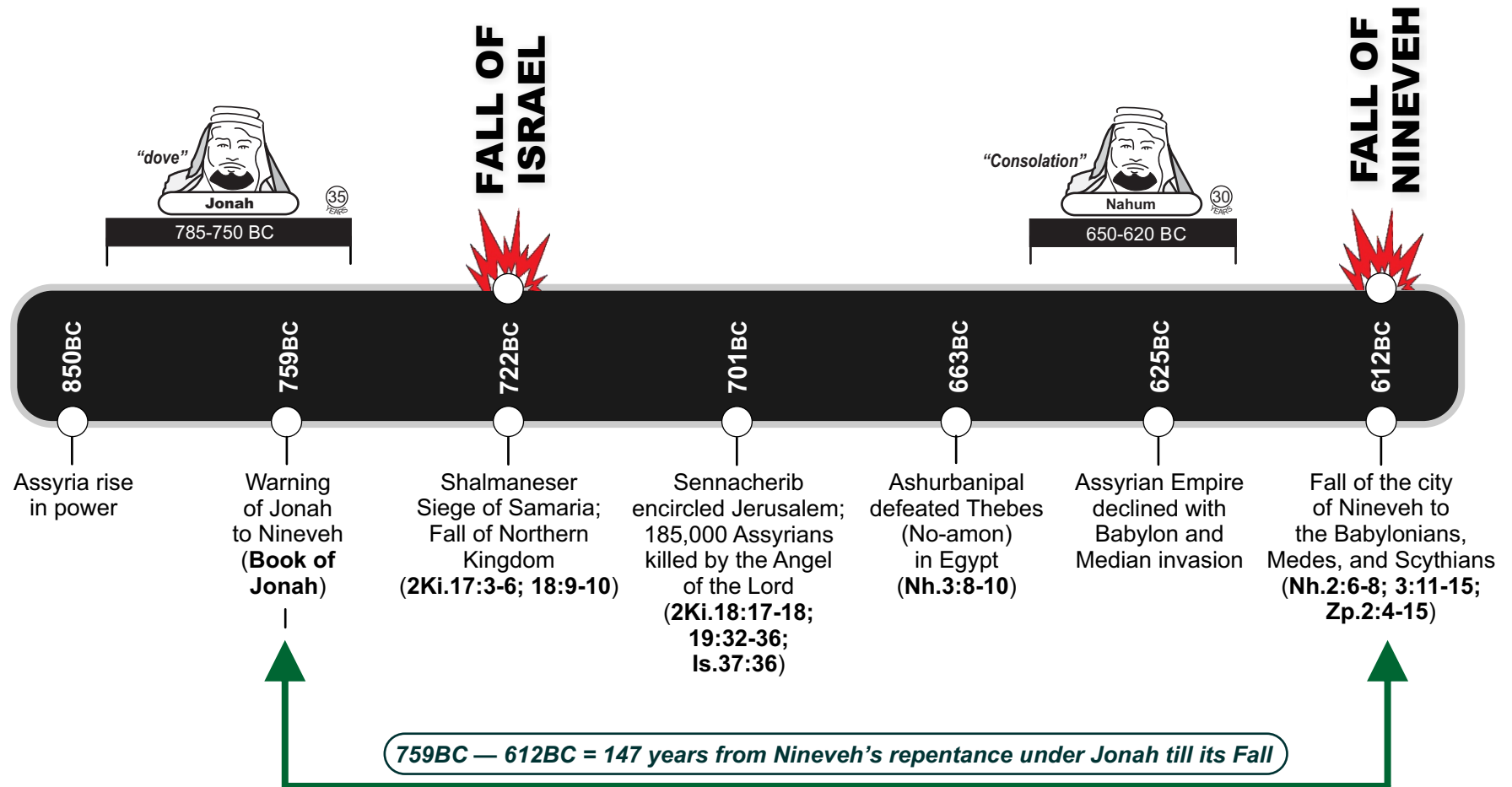


NINEVEH: JONAH AND NAHUM



NOTES

- Nineveh first mentioned (**Ge.10:11-12**)
- Under Jeroboam II Assyria's power was weak enough for Israel to expand her borders (**2Ki.14:25**)
- The book of Nahum should be read in the light of the book of Jonah.
- Nahum was followed by Zephaniah, who also predicted the destruction of Nineveh (**Zp.2:4-15**).
- The Assyrian empire came to an end (612BC), and has never been rebuilt to this day.
- Nineveh returned to their bullish ways, conquering the northern kingdom, and lording their power over Judah (**2Ki.17:1-6; 18:13—19:37**).
- From around 734BC until the fall of Nineveh, the people of Judah were under the subjugation of Assyria.
