
## **NINEVEH: JONAH AND NAHUM**



## **NOTES**

- Nineveh first mentioned (Ge.10:11-12)
- Under Jeroboam II Assyria's power was weak enough for Israel to expand her borders (2Ki.14:25)
- The book of Nahum should be read in the light of the book of Jonah.
- Nahum was followed by Zephaniah, who also predicted the destruction of Nineveh (Zp.2:4-15).
- The Assyrian empire came to an end (612BC), and has never been rebuilt to this day.
- Nineveh returned to their bullish ways, conquering the northern kingdom, and lording their power over Judah (2Ki.17:1-6; 18:13—19:37).
- From around 734BC until the fall of Nineveh, the people of Judah were under the subjugation of Assyria.
