

ZECHARIAH: PROPHECIES CONCERNING CHRIST

Zechariah refers to Christ's first and second coming in many passages. Only Isaiah refers to Christ more than any other Old Testament book. Christ is the theme of the book of Zechariah. Jesus is the Savior of Israel. His blood covers the sins of all who come to Him (**Zc.13:1; 1Jn.1:7**).

Christ's Deity

- "the man that is my fellow" (**13:7**). Meaning "companion" or "equal" (H5997). He is eternal (Mi.5:2, "from everlasting")

Christ My Servant

- "I will bring forth my servant the BRANCH" (**3:8**)

Christ's Humanity

- "Behold the man whose name is The BRANCH" (**6:12**)
- "the man that is my fellow" (**13:7**)



Christ's Humility

- "he shall grow up out of his place" (**6:12**)
- "lowly, and riding upon an ass, and upon a colt the foal of an ass" (**9:9**; See Mt.21:4-5; Jn.12:14-16)



Christ's Priesthood

- "he shall be a priest upon his throne" (**6:13**)



Christ the Smitten Shepherd

- "smite the shepherd" (**13:7**; See Mt.26:31; Mk.14:27)



Christ Entrance to Jerusalem on a Colt

- "riding upon an ass, and upon a colt the foal of an ass" (**9:9**; See Mt.21:5; Jn.12:13)



Christ Betrayed for 30 Pieces of Silver

- "they weighed for my price thirty pieces of silver" (**11:12-13**; See Mt.14:27)



Christ Hands Pierced

- "they shall look upon me whom they have pierced" (**12:10**)



Christ Wounded in the House of His Friends

- "I was wounded in the house of my friends" (**13:6**)

Christ the Good Shepherd

- "as the flock of his people" (**9:16**)
- "the poor of the flock that waited upon me" (**11:11**)



Christ's Kingship

- "shall sit and rule upon his throne" (**6:13**)
- "behold, thy King cometh unto thee" (**9:9**)
- "And the LORD shall be king over all the earth" (**14:9**)
- "to worship the King" (**14:16**)



Christ's Glorious Reign

- "his dominion shall be from sea even to sea" (**9:10**)
- "the LORD shall be seen over them" (**9:14**)



Christ's World Peace

- "every man his neighbor under the vine and under the fig tree" (**3:10**)
- "he shall speak peace unto the heathen" (**9:10**)



Christ the Branch

- "I will bring forth my servant the BRANCH" (**3:8**)
- "whose name is The BRANCH" (**6:12**)



Christ Coming to the Mount of Olives

- "I will bring forth my servant the BRANCH" (**3:8**)
- "his feet shall stand in that day upon the mount of Olives" (**14:4** [context: 14:3-8] See Ac.1:11, "shall so come")



Christ's Coronation

- "the LORD shall be king over all the earth" (**14:9**)



Christ Builds the Lord's Temple

- "he shall build the temple of the LORD" (**6:12-13**)
