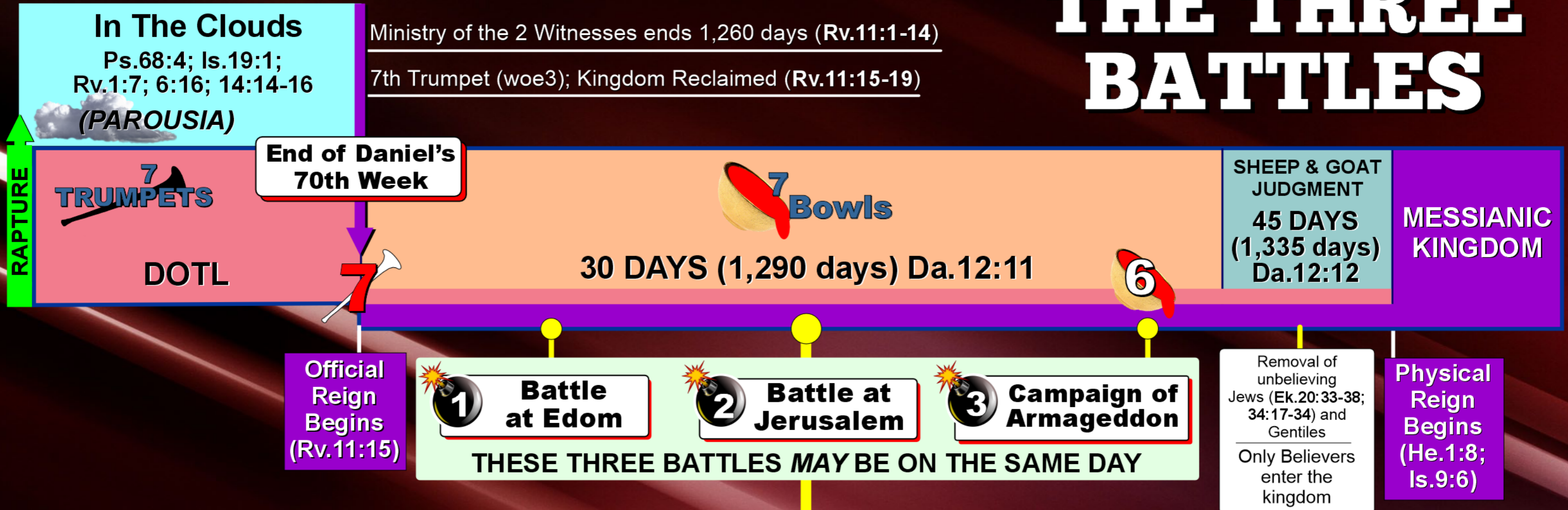


THE THREE BATTLES



- An advance of the king of the North throughout the world and into Israel (Ek.38-39; Je.25:15-38; Jl.2:1-11; Rv.9:13-21).
- The Northern alliance will be composed of many nations (Ek.38:2-6). It is only the king of the North and alliance that invade Jerusalem.
- This invasion of Jerusalem by the king of the North will trigger other nations to come, leading to Armageddon (Jl.3:2,9-14; Rv.16:12-16; 19:17-19).
- The motivation for coming to Israel will be to 'de-throne' the Beast and to gain resources (Ek.38:12, "to take plunder and to take booty").
- The king of the North will advance throughout the Beast's kingdom (6th trumpet). The final demise of the beast is described (Da.11:40-45)
- Because the King of the West returns to Jerusalem, it will cause the King of the North's army to split in two (Da.11:45; Jl.2:20).
- After the Northern army is divided, Jesus descends to the Mount of Olives causing an East-West valley (Zc.14:4).
