Theme:

God charges the priests and people with failure to keep His covenant but offers hope of

the Messiah, the Messenger of the covenant who would bring justice and salvation.

Written:

Malachi was likely written when Nehemiah returned to Persia (433-424BC).

Christ in Malachi anticipates the first and second comings of Christ. Christ comes to fulfill God's coverlant

Malachi: with Israel (3:1), judge sinners (3:2-5), and bring spiritual healing to those who fear the Lord (4:2).
