**Matthew 24:29-31** 

Pretribbers view the gathering of the elect in Mt.24:31 as occurring at the end of Daniel's 70th Week. They see the elect as saved Israel and the wicked as unbelievers left behind who are about to face Armageddon.

How can the world go on with their ordinary business completely oblivious to impending judgment, having already experienced the trumpet and bowl judgments, and still have the Lord come as a thief (Noah, Lot, Mt.24)?

Anyone undergoing the trumpet and bowl judgments would not be able to live an ordinary life and be caught off guard as a 'thief' (Rv.9:21; 16:9,11). Everyone alive at that time will see and know it is from God (Is.2:11,17).

Paul also points out that those enjoying "peace and safety" will find "sudden destruction comes upon them, as labor pains" as believers are delivered (1Th.5:3).
