## **UNPARALLELED PERIOD OF TIME**

**TEXT NOTE** 

<sup>1</sup> Blow the trumpet in Zion, And sound an alarm in My holy mountain! Let all the inhabitants of the land tremble; For <u>the day of the LORD is coming</u> , For it is at hand: <sup>2</sup> A day of darkness and gloominess, A day of clouds and thick darkness, Like the morning clouds spread over the mountains. A people come, great and strong, <u>The like of whom has never been; Nor will there ever be any such after them</u> , Even for many successive generations. ( <b>Jl.2:1-2</b> )	This is an "alarm" warning that the "day of the LORD is coming". Thus, this unparalleled period of time may include the day of the LORD.
At that time Michael shall stand up, The great prince who stands watch over the sons of your people; And <u>there shall be a time of trouble</u> , <u>Such as never</u> <u>was since there was a nation</u> , Even to that time. And at that time your people shall be delivered, Every one who is found written in the book. ( <b>Da.12:1</b> )	Michael, who watches over Israel, will "stand up" which initiates a "time of trouble", yet those "in the book" will be "delivered"
Alas! For that day is great, <u>So that none is like it</u> ; And it is the time of Jacob's trouble, But he shall be saved out of it. ( <b>Je.30:7</b> )	This is called the "time of Jacob's trouble"
For then there will be great tribulation, such as has <u>not been since the</u> beginning of the world until this time, no, <u>nor ever shall be</u> . (Mt.24:21)	It is called "great tribulation"
For in those days there will be tribulation, such as has <u>not been since the</u> <u>beginning</u> of the creation which God created until this time, <u>nor ever</u> <u>shall be</u> ( <b>Mk.13:19</b> )	It is called "tribulation"

This is the time just prior to the start of the Day of the LORD. This is the period of time between the "abomination of desolation" (Mt.24:15) at the mid-point of Daniel's 70th Week, and Christ's coming for His saints (Mt.24:29-31). Jesus spoke of this period being "shortened" lest "no flesh" would survive it (Mt.24:22). This period is shortened for the elect's sake.
