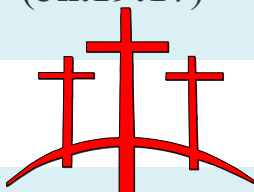


# FULFILLED PROPHECY OF THE CROSS BRINGS GLORY

## PRECISION OF FULFILLMENT (JOHN 19:16-30)

- 1** “Then he delivered Him to them” (Jn.19:16)
- 2** “to be crucified” (Jn.19:16)
- 3** “Then he delivered Him to them to be crucified” (Jn.19:16)
- 4** “And He, bearing His cross” (Jn.19:17)
- 5** “went out ” (Jn.19:17)
- 6** “two others with Him, one on either side, and Jesus in the center” (Jn.19:18)
- 7** “Pilate wrote a title” (Jn.19:19-22)
- 8** “tunic...cast lots for it” (Jn.19:23-24)
- 9** “everyone will believe in Him” (Jn.11:48)



## PAUL BOASTED IN THE CROSS (GA.6:14)

- Jesus was led not driven or dragged to His death fulfilling Scripture
- By crucifying Him they lifted Him up instead of execution by stoning
- The Romans and Jews violated their own laws to execute Jesus and accomplish God's plan
- When they made Him carry His cross they were fulfilling a beautiful OT picture
- When they took Him outside the city they fulfilled the intension of the sin offering
- He was crucified among thieves fulfilling being numbered with transgressors
- In Pilate's vengeance against the Jews He wrote the truth about Jesus
- They split the four pieces of clothing and gambled for the fifth
- Through shame and vengeance God orchestrated the cross to bring glory to Christ
