Matthew called it "the next day, the one after Preparation Day" so that it would not be confused with the weekly sabbath. • 1st month (Nisan 14) at twilight starts the Lord's Passover (Le.23:5). • On the 1st day of the 7 days of Unleavened Bread, no laborious work is to be done (Le.23:7). • For 7 days they shall present an offering before the LORD (Le.23:8).	UNLEAVENED BREAD	WEEKLY SABBATH	• Then "on the Sabbath they rested according to the commandment" (Lk.23:56b).	• The 2 Marys, "when the Sabbath was over," bought spices (Mk.16:1). • "After the Sabbath" (Mt.28:1) is plural, that is, after the "Sabbaths". Christ was in the grave through 2 Sabbaths (Lk.23:55-56). • After the resurrection, Christ and two men walked on the road to Emmaus.
