

JESUS' CLAIM FOR HIMSELF

SALVATION

1 I AM the BREAD OF LIFE — JOHN 6:22-35

“And Jesus said to them, “I am the bread of life. He who comes to Me shall never hunger, and he who believes in Me shall never thirst.” (Jn.6:35)

CORRECTIONS

- A. It was not Moses who gave you the manna from heaven; it was God (Ex.16:4).
- B. In the wilderness it was only manna; it was not true or spiritual bread (Jn.6:49).
- C. Moses' bread gave only physical nourishment (Jn.6:54).
- D. Manna was for Israel; true bread is for the world (Jn.6:33).



2 I AM the LIVING WATER — JOHN 7:37-39

“On the last day, that great day of the feast, Jesus stood and cried out, saying, “If anyone thirsts, let him come to Me and drink.” (Jn.7:37)

- The Gospel: You are “thirsty”; then “come” and “drink.”
- It does not do you any good to be thirsty and have it in your hand; you have to get it inside.



3 I AM the LIGHT OF THE WORLD — JOHN 8:12-20

“Then Jesus spoke to them again, saying, “I am the light of the world. He who follows Me shall not walk in darkness, but have the light of life.” (Jn.8:12)

- We live in a dark world. But we are ‘sons of light and of the day’ (1Th.5:5). We know spiritual things because we have the HS who teaches us His Word.



CARES FOR US

4 I AM the GOOD SHEPHERD — JOHN 10:1-21

“I am the good shepherd. The good shepherd gives His life for the sheep.” (Jn.10:11)

ASPECTS

- A. The Good Shepherd is the DOOR (Jn.10:7). This is security.
- B. The Good Shepherd LEADS Us (Jn.10:27). He leads them by going before them. They follow.
- C. The Good Shepherd LOVES His Sheep (Jn.10:14). He loves me and knows me personally.
- D. The Good Shepherd DIED for His sheep (Jn.10:11). He would die for the sheep that are His.



5 I AM the RESURRECTION and the LIFE — JOHN 11:17-27

“Jesus said to her, “I am the resurrection and the life. He who believes in Me, though he may die, he shall live.” (Jn.11:25)
