NEW COVENANT SEED BLESSING

CHRIST: THE SEED

- "Your father Abraham rejoiced to see My day and he saw it and was glad" (Jn.8:56)
 - Abraham understood to some degree the coming Redeemer (Jn.8:56).
- Now to Abraham and his Seed were the promises made. He does not say, "And to seeds," as of many, but as of one, "AND TO YOUR SEED," who is Christ (Ga.3:16).
 - When God made the promise to Abraham, He said the ultimate promised seed is not seeds, but Christ (**Ga.3:16**).

Christ is the Seed

ONE IN CHRIST

- "And if you are Christ's, then you are Abraham's seed, and heirs according to the promise" (Ga.3:29).
 - When one trusts in Christ we are identified with the one seed because we are one in Him.
- "And if children, then heirs—heirs of God and joint heirs with Christ" (Ro.8:17).
 - As joint heirs with Christ, we inherit what God grants to Christ.
- "²¹Therefore let no one boast in men. For all things are yours: ²²whether Paul or Apollos or Cephas, or the world or life or death, or things present or things to come—all are yours. ²³And you are Christ's, and Christ is God's" (1Co.3:21-23).

We are Connected to Christ

BLESSING

- For the promise that he would be the heir of the world was not to Abraham or to his seed through the law, but through the righteousness of faith (Ro.4:13).
 - All believers are "heir of the world" by being "in Christ." (Ro.4:13)
- "Therefore know that only those who are of faith are sons of Abraham..." (Ga.3:7-9).
 - Through faith alone in Christ the families of the earth find blessing becoming Abraham's spiritual descendants. We are not outsiders, but full members of the Abrahamic family.
- "And if you are Christ's, then you are Abraham's seed, and heirs according to the promise" (Ga.3:29).
 - We are not second class citizens but are incorporated into the Israel of God whether Jew or Gentile (**Ga.3:29; Ep.2:11-16**).
